



Point of Service (POS)

Medicare telehealth services are generally billed as if the service had been furnished in-person- DSMT would still be billed under the Program NPI# using G0108 for 1:1 and G0109 for group. Prior to March 30, 2020, CMS advised the use of the Place of Service (POS) 02 modifier. As of March 30, CMS is now asking providers to report the POS code that would have been reported had the services been provided in person. For example, you may use the POS 11 modifier to indicate a service that would have been provided in an office. CMS has also directed providers to report the 95 modifier for services reported via telehealth. You should now use the appropriate POS modifier and the 95 modifier. The POS code 02 code is not incorrect, CMS has just added more specific guidance.

Pumps and CGM

pump supplies, and test strips

- In March 30 IFC, CMS announced they will temporarily waive face-to-face requirements for coverage of CGM supplies, insulin
- CMS has also indicated that they will not enforce the clinical indications for coverage for certain policies, including those policies for insulin pumps (NCD 280.14, LCD L33794).
- These changes are designed to ensure flexibility for providers and beneficiaries
